#### **Scholarship Requirements:**

Each applicant must be an African-American graduating senior who is a member of CAAP. The applicant must graduate high school by June 2021 and qualify for college enrollment beginning the 2021/2022. Please see scholarship descriptions below.

#### **The CAAP Scholarship (\$500.00)**

- Must have a 3.0 Grade Point Average
- One (1) Essay
- One (1) Letter of Recommendation
- Must show proof of enrollment into a four-year university
- One (1) page description of a famous man of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc.

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## **APPLICATION SUBMISSION INFORMATION**

The following documents must be submitted by the application deadline:

1. The **Scholarship Applicant Information Form** must be completed by the applicant and signed by a counselor or administrator. Due to COVID-19 restrictions, counselors and/or administrators may email transcripts, or GPA confirmations to: [undray@bmbfoods.net](mailto:undray@bmbfoods.net). GPA confirmations must be on official school letterhead.
2. Applicants must submit a **typed essay** (double spaced, Times New Roman font, 12-point pitch), not to exceed four (4) pages. Must include the following information:
  - (a) Applicant's leadership role(s) and responsibilities at school and in the community.
  - (b) Explanation of what the effect or importance a college education will have on the applicant's future.
  - (c) Explanation of the applicant's career aspirations and the impact the applicant hopes to have on society.
3. Applicants must submit a **one (1) page description** of a famous man of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. Please follow the same format required for the essay. (See pg.3)
4. **One (1) letter of recommendation** from a faculty member or community leader. Recommendations from immediate family will not be accepted.
5. Submit an **official transcript**.
6. Provide a **recent photograph** of the applicant, portrait type, minimum 3x5, with the applicant's first and last name affixed.

### **General Information:**

**Deadline - Monday, May 3, 2021**

**Scholarship awards will be distributed directly to the recipient upon verification of enrollment in an accredited college or university.**
